COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

1. Municipal and Community Insurance

Council invited our municipal insurance Manager, Jason Gervais, to present information on how the Township may be able to assist community groups and facility users. This is in follow up to the delegation of May 13, 2025 from Debra Helm, the organizer of the Bonfield Farmers' Market.

Mr. Gervais explained there are 13 different policies under the municipal insurance program including buildings, automobiles, errors and omissions and another one being liability insurance. Liability insurance was the main policy for discussions as it relates to community events and municipal functions. This coverage applies to Council members, staff, committees of Council and their members all while performing their duties. If the Township hosts an event, such as Canada Day, any activities leading up to and associated with that event may be covered. Vendors at the event would not be insured under the municipal program. He further offered that there is a third party option under the Facility User Program, where the Township provides a deposit based on the expected number of rentals throughout the year and then each event/vendor/renter could purchase their insurance coverage through that program at reasonable rates. This program is administered by the Township but there is no financial impact to the Township. Council requested additional information to consider the program.
